
Public Health Assessment And Accreditation

10 Essential Public Health Services:

- Monitor health status to identify and solve community health problems.
- 2. **Diagnose and investigate** health problems and health hazards in the community.
- Inform, educate, and empower people about health issues.
- Mobilize community partnerships and action to identify and solve health problems.
- Develop policies and plans that support individual and community health efforts.
- 6. **Enforce** laws and regulations that protect health and ensure safety.
- Link people to needed personal health services and assure the provision of health care when otherwise unavailable.
- Ensure competent public and personal health care workforces.
- Evaluate effectiveness, accessibility, and quality of personal and population-based health services.
- Research for new insights and innovative solutions to health problems.

Increasing attention to public health infrastructure has led to the identification of a number of emerging issues. These issues are influenced by:


- Tribal Public Health Infrastructure
